QQI Level 5
Major Award



This programme is intensive and rewarding for the learner providing the practical experience and knowledge needed for employment in the Heritage and Tourism industry.

The Dublinia Cultural and Heritage programme, delivered in collaboration with the City of Dublin Education Training Board (CDETb), is a QQI Level 5 Major award. The programme combines training and work experience over 11 months. Participants benefit from work experience in Dublinia Heritage Centre, St. Patrick's Cathedral and a site of the learner's choice. Learners also benefit from familiarisation trips to other heritage sites around Ireland.



THE AIMS OF THIS COURSE

- To enable the learner to acquire the knowledge, skill and competence in a range of core disciplines in Irish culture and heritage studies.
- To demonstrate a broad range of knowledge in the disciplines of Archaeology, Folklore and Ethnology, History and other areas of study relevant to Irish culture and heritage.
- To apply the skills and tools of research, interpretation and presentation implicit in the study of Irish culture and heritage.
- To demonstrate personal appreciation and critical awareness of new learning in the areas of cultural and heritage studies.
- To engage positively with others, apply a broad range of verbal and non-verbal communication skills in the managed learning environment and/or the learner's individual work experience situation.
- Certified Modules: Local History, Heritage, Folklore and Ethnology, Appreciation of Irish Culture, Work Experience, Archaeology, Communications, Customer Service, First Aid and Manual Handling. Learners also participate in weekly French classes with a French tutor.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum QQI Level 4 Major Award or its equivalent
- 18 years or over
- Fluent English - both oral and written
- Basic computer literacy

COURSE DURATION

The course is full time running for 50 weeks. The hours are 9am-4:15pm Monday-Friday with weekend work and bank holidays required during work experience.

FEES

There are no charges or fees for this programme. Successful applicants will receive a weekly allowance as per the CDETb training allowance.
